Holocaust survivor evaded the Nazis



YOU'RE NEVER TOO OLD

Berta Lovinger, 96, at Ben Gurion Airport, after her arrival in Israel from Outremont, Montreal. Berta was met by her five grandchildren and will stay with her daughter and son-in-law, Miriam and Ithamar Pollack, in Petach Tikvah. They came on *aliyah* themselves, just four months ago from Connecticut. Berta came to Canada in 1949 from Hungary, having evaded the Nazis by procuring Aryan papers. Lovinger was on the last flight of the year organized by Nefesh B'Nefesh, which brought more than 3,000 North American and British Jews to Israel in 2007.
