

Required Documents – Psychology

Here is a list of the documents required in order to open a file with the Medical Professions Licensing Department:

- 2 **passport photos**
- [Questionnaire for Psychology Professionals](#)
- Photocopy of **Israeli identification card** noting Israeli citizenship (or your foreign passport).
- Original bachelor's degree grade sheet - transcript** (the transcript must include the details of the credits or the number of academic hours in each of the courses).*
- Photocopy of bachelor's degree diploma** - notarized as a true copy of the original by an Israeli notary.*
- Original master's degree grade sheet- transcript** (the transcript must include the details of the credits or the number of academic hours in each of the courses).*
- Photocopy of the master's degree diploma** - notarized as a true copy of the original by an Israeli notary.*
- Syllabuses of the courses:** especially courses in the field of psychology, research methods and statistics
- License/Expert certificate** - board certifications (if applicable) – certified copies *
- Professional CV** - detailed from graduation to application
- Professional integrity certificate** (letter of good standing) by the relevant authorities from the applicant's state of license, confirming that there were no disciplinary, malpractice or ethics complaints against the applicant as a practitioner in the field of psychology **To be mailed directly from the professional board of the state in which you are licensed to the Israeli Ministry of Health**

For holders of a PsyD/PhD degree:

- Original PsyD/PhD grade sheet –transcript** (the transcript must include the details of the credits or the number of academic hours in each of the courses).*
 - Confirmation from the university that the doctorate was written within the framework of the School of Psychology.***
 - Photocopy of the PhD diploma** notarized as a true copy of the original by an Israeli notary.*
 - Syllabuses of the courses:** especially courses in the field of psychology, research methods and statistics

- Certificate of equivalence** for each of the relevant degrees studied abroad (starting from bachelor's degree). The certificate must be obtained from the Department for the Evaluation of Academic Degrees from Abroad in the Ministry of Education of Israel.
Please note that you may only submit a request for a Certificate of Equivalence once you have obtained Aliya approval from the Jewish Agency or Israeli citizenship and have an **Israeli identification number.

* You can submit a notarized copy authenticated by an Israeli notary instead of sending the original document. Please note that an Israeli notary will be available for your use at the conference.
